YOUTH EMERGENCY SERVICES Where Change Begins

SafeHouse of the Desert's twenty-one day program provides immediate help to youth, ages 11-17, who are experiencing emergency situations. SafeHouse is open twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week to assist youth and families in crisis. Services include: Individual, group, and family counseling, life skills, substance abuse education, anti-human trafficking program, family support services, parenting classes, anger management, continuing on-site education, and aftercare.

With programs in both the Coachella Valley and Riverside, SafeHouse of the Desert is well equipped to help runaway, homeless and other youth in crisis. Teens who don't know where else to go are always welcome at SafeHouse—all they have to do is show up at our door or a designated Safe Place site.

TRANSITIONAL LIVING PROGRAM Building Futures and Permanency

SafeHouse of the Desert's Transitional Living Program, Harrison House, is a 15-unit complex located just behind the shelter. Harrison House offers homeless young adults, ages 18-21, a place to learn the skills they need to make the transition from homelessness to successful independent adulthood. Education and employment assistance are provided to help the young adults achieve their academic goals and secure employment. Individualized case management and therapy are designed specifically to meet every individual's needs. The young adults in this program are encouraged to start building their futures and are provided with the tools they need to be successful and live self-sufficiently.

YOUNG ADULT EMERGENCY SERVICES Restoring Dignity and Well-Being

Operation SafeHouse's Main S.T.A.Y. Program is a 30 day program that provides older homeless youth ages 18-24 with assistance in their journey from the streets into shelter and/or permanent housing.

Once the youth enters the Main S.T.A.Y program, they have access to a Case Manager who will assist them in creating an individualized service plan, obtaining medical health assistance, documentation, secondary education, life skills training, financial education and employment. Clinicians provide individualized mental health counseling to restore the youth's resiliency and well-being.
